## PROACTIVE ENVIRONMENT HEALTH & SAFETY

Starting with pre-employment safety competency reviews of supervisors to enhancing engagement with frontline workers on the daily safety front, Nuna continually focuses on safety improvements in all aspects of our work. Nuna utilizes the expertise of on-site safety professionals to support Nuna's project managers and supervision teams in their pursuit of a "No Incident" worksite. Nuna's corporate safety manager works closely with operations and construction management in the creation, implementation and monitoring of the safety and training programs.

Employees attend daily tool box and weekly safety meetings to discuss potential hazards and concerns, and to discuss corrective action taken. Employees receive an extensive orientation outlining their job description, corporate policies, rules of conduct and safe work practices specific to their job function. Safety is an integral part of each Nuna employee's job description.
